CHRISTUS Mother Frances Hospital – *Tyler*

The PGY-1 program is conducted at CHRISTUS Mother Frances Hospital – *Tyler*, a not-for-profit, community hospital in East Texas.

A high priority is placed on teaching evidence-based care and preparing residents for the variety of opportunities available to PGY-1 graduates.

- All application material submitted through PhORCAS
- Doctor of Pharmacy degree from an ACPE accredited School of Pharmacy
- Eligible for licensure with the Texas State Board of Pharmacy
- » All licensing tests must be attempted no later than June 23, 2023
- Official college(s) of pharmacy transcript(s)
- Letter of intent
- Curriculum Vitae
- » Include completed and anticipated advanced pharmacy practice experiences
- Three letters of recommendation
- » Direct patient care APPE preceptors **recommended**
- GPA ≥ 3.0
- Selected applicants will be interviewed
